Anesthesia: the facts

HOW IT WORKS

There are several stages involved in putting a pet under.

- Pre-anesthetic evaluation: -Our veterinarians conduct a thorough physical exam and recommend pre-surgery blood work to test for signs of disease. It is also important for owners to report any out of the ordinary that's going on at home.
- Premedication: This includes drugs for sedation and pain control . The use of pain-killers throughout the process is major improvement compared to 30 years ago when it was common practice to not use pre-meds. "because animals felt no pain" and did not need anesthetics.

Giving pain medications before, during and after the procedure has been shown to speed recovery.

- Inhalant anesthetic: The animal is rendered unconscious through the use of an inhaled drug is ready for the procedure.
- Recovery: After the procedure, the inhalant is turned off. The animal starts to wake up in about 20 minutes They are monitored until they are fully awake. We then offer them a light meal with water. We then move them to their regular room. Owners should monitor for problems even after their pet goes home. Although grogginess for a few days in not uncommon after

Here a Companion Animal Hospital All spays and declaws spend the night and neuter and dentals go home the same day. We like to sit up a check - out time so our doctors can go over your homecare and answer any questions you may have All of our surgeries have sutures that are entirely internal , which mean no suture removal. However, we like to recheck all of our surgery patient 1 week after their procedure to be sure everything going ok

Can you imagine being lost and unable to find your family? Sadly, pets are lost more often than you might expect: many with tragic consequences

Here are some tips for keeping your pet safe and at home:

1. **Good Fences:** There is no substitute for a good fence, but don't believe your pet won't try to get out even the best fence at some point. For get about cats and fences. Cats think of a fence as a bridge.
2. **Electronic Fences:** Invisible-type fences which emit a small shock to your dog's neck. With this fence you must properly train your dog ensure he will stay in his yard.
3. **Spay and Neuter:** The number one cause for roaming is "looking for love in all the wrong places". When pets enter their reproductive cycles, they emit odors that we can not smell but, other dogs can. If your male dog or cat decides he wants to investigate, there's no stopping him even with a fence.

4. **Identification Tag:** It's easy and cheap and they are available at pet stores. Put your name, address, phone, email and your pet's name. Tags are a must!

5. **Microchip:** A small electronic chip the size of a grain of rice that is injected under the skin at your vet's office. When an animal is found, the animal is scanned at the shelter or vet clinic. The scanner reads the code which can be traced to the owner.. Microchips are great and lifelong.

Doing all of our suggestions does not insure your pet will never get lost but, at least you did all that you could.

1. Call your veterinarian
2. Contact all your neighbors, friends and family
3. Put signs up in your neighborhood, pet store ect..
4. Call your local radio station (KFDD IN WICHITA)
5. Call all surrounding veterinarian offices
